



Strawberries

Market steady on very light demand. Northern District: - Steady weekly decline continuing. New crop planting to start next week. Good to fair quality. Santa Maria - Production in steady downtrend. Good quality. Oxnard - Production in steep ramp up. Peak still expected early November. Strong quality. C-Mex volume increasing steadily. Good to fair quality.



Blackberries

Market steady with moderate demand. California production steady. Northern district good quality with minimal leaky/reversion. Santa Maria good quality. Oxnard good quality. Baja minimal volume and downtrend remainder of year. CMex continues production uptrend. Generally good and improved quality.



Blueberries

Market steady at high prices with fairly good demand. Volumes improving. Peru volume increasing quickly with more U.S. arrivals. Good quality. CMex continued light volumes with stronger volumes still expected in November. Overall good quality. Light/sporadic Baja volume continues. Light coastal U.S. volumes w/strong quality and consistent flavor.



Raspberries

Market steady on moderate demand. California production downtrend continues and will accelerate in Nov/Dec. Good quality. Baja in post peak production. Overall good quality. CMex production will peak in the next 4 weeks. Fair to good quality.



Cactus Pears

Growing season is ending soon. Volumes dropped this week with colder temperatures. Quality remains good, but prices are rising due to consistent demand.



Jicama

Jicama remains in storage as we await new crops from Mexico. Expect lower volumes, higher prices, and potentially lower quality during these transition weeks.



Beets

Demand has slowed a little and new regions starting to show supplies. Prices are starting to drop.



Chili Peppers

Baja & Central California chili pepper and tomatillo volumes are low. Chihuahua, Mexico product is supplementing supply until the Sinaloa season starts in early Nov. Quality is declining, and prices rising. Demand is steady, but should increase in Nov. Anaheim and Pasilla peppers from La Paz arrive this week.



Mexican Maridol Papaya

Colima and Nayarit chili pepper volumes are down, pushing prices. No improvement is expected through Nov.



Persian Cucumbers

Unexpected cold weather in Baja this weekend drastically reduced cucumber volumes & raised prices. Demand is average. Growers will maintain winter supply by moving cucumbers indoors.



Loose Poly Radish

Strong supplies out of the growing regions Michigan & Oregon.



Parsnips

Stable. New crop supplies out of Oregon and Michigan. Good quality. Prices remain stable.



Turnips

Stable, starting to see a good mix of sizes. New crop supplies out of Oregon and Michigan. Solid quality. Starting to see increased demand as approach cooler weather. Price also remain stable.



Heirloom Tomatoes

Local supplies finished starting to see supplies out of Nogales and Baja Mexico.



Shell Eggs

Shell egg prices have increased. This price increase is due to an egg shortage in the market, and our vendors have been forced to reduce our allocated quantities.



Rutabaga

New crop Oregon. Great quality & steady demand. Stable prices.
